

DCBC Small Group Questions: Amy Jones – Mark 4:21-34

In the service we celebrated Palm Sunday, when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. You can read what Mark says about this event in chapter 11, verses 1 to 11.

1. Who do you think receives the most praise in our modern culture?
2. Do you think most people in the crowd were genuinely praising Jesus, or were they caught up in the hype, or only cheering because they thought he would free them from the Romans?
3. Why do you think we develop incomplete or inaccurate views of Jesus?
4. What is a step you can take this week to help you have more gratitude and praise for Jesus?

Amy focussed her sermon on the two parables in Mark chapter 4, verses 26 to 32

1. What stands out to you about the Kingdom of God in these two parables?
2. Is there a time in your life when you felt your service was unfruitful but then discovered God had been at work?
3. Do these verses change the way you look at your current serving?
4. What can help us persevere and wait on God when progress seems painfully slow?
5. How can we encourage each other to wait on God, without coming across as insensitive?
6. Is there a current situation where you feel impatient with God?
